

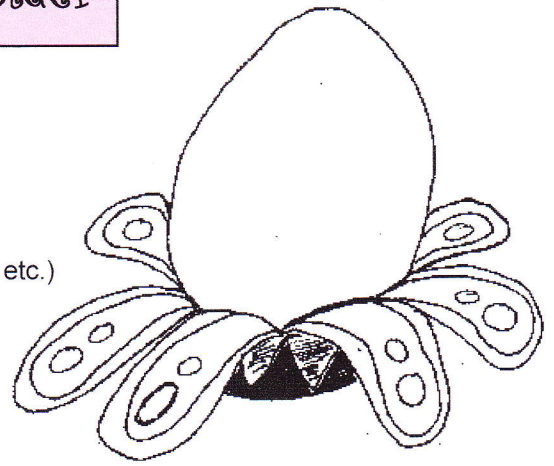
Decorative Egg Holder

Materials:

- ♦ paper to print pattern onto
- ♦ Textas to draw patterns on with
- ♦ scissors, glue
- ♦ a hard boiled or chocolate egg

Optional:

- ♦ * a cardboard ring to glue base onto (cut from paper towel roll etc.)
- ♦ a strip of coloured paper to cover the cardboard ring
- ♦ stickers, dots, stars, hearts, butterflies etc to decorate



What to do:

- ♦ Print the egg holder pattern below onto paper.
- ♦ Decorate as preferred.
Note: Decorate petals on opposite side of the paper to the base.
Colour in before cutting out.
- ♦ Cut out the egg holder. Cut on all solid lines.
- ♦ Form it into a circle and glue ends together.
- ♦ *Optional:* Before gluing ends together, glue the base onto a cardboard ring. *
- ♦ *Optional:* If the base hasn't been coloured in, glue a strip of coloured paper around the base.
- ♦ Roll the petals round a pencil to make them curl a little.
- ♦ Sit a decorated hard-boiled egg or chocolate egg in it.

* **NB.** The paper holder is strong enough to hold an egg, but gluing it to a cardboard ring gives it extra staying power.
