

Early Christian Communities: Sharing and Caring

3D Shared Meal picture

Bible references: Acts 4: 32-35; Psalm 133: 1-3

You will need:

- the background sheet and pictures of the people and plates of food
- coloured pencils or felt pens
- glue stick, scissors
- polystyrene foam sheet, about 1cm thick, cut into cubes: 6-12 cubes
- cardboard from a cereal packet

What to do:

- Print off the background sheet. Print it on sandy-coloured paper if you have it.
- Trim the picture to the border and glue it onto a piece of recycled cardboard from a cereal packet.
- Print off the pictures of the people.
- Colour in the people. Cut them out.
- Glue the group of 4 people to the back of the room.
- Glue the plates & bowls of food in front of them.
- Glue 1-2 polystyrene cubes to the back of each of the other figures. Then glue the other side of the cubes to the paper so the figures are in the foreground of the picture.
- Write a phrase from Psalm 133: ***How pleasant it is when people live in peace with each other.***
- Or from Acts 4: ***Everything they owned was shared, and no-one was in need.***
