

Gate Collage

You will need:

- green card, A5
- sheep, shepherd, thief & wolf figures downloaded from <http://www.cranialhiccups.com/2007/11/the-good-shepherd.html> and printed on white cardboard
- gate & fence cut-outs
- scissors, glue sticks, sticky tape
- polystyrene blocks (optional)

What to do:

- Choose the figures you want to use.
- Cut them out. Arrange them on the page.
- Glue polystyrene blocks to the back of the fence posts.
- Sticky tape the gate to the left-hand fence so it can open as if hinged.
- Glue the sheep to the background in the upper half of the green card.
- Glue the fence posts to the foreground edges.
- Glue the shepherd either behind the gate or to the fence.
- Glue either a thief or a wolf to the outside of the fence or gate.

Other ideas: Make a field and stand-up figures:

Make a sheepfold from the fence posts and gate to enfold the sheep.

Make figures that stand up by putting a block of polystyrene or a triangle of cardboard behind each figure.

Use the fenced in sheepfold and the figures to show how the shepherd protects the sheep from the thief and the wolf.
