Matthew 10: 40-42

Whoever welcomes you welcomes me; and whoever welcomes me welcomes the one who sent me. Whoever welcomes God's messenger will share in his reward. And whoever welcomes a good man because he is good, will share in his reward. You can be sure that whoever gives even a drink of cold water to one of the least of these my followers because he is my follower, will certainly receive a reward.

Discuss with children how they can make a contribution to making their home welcoming. How does making someone feel comfortable and welcome make you feel?

You might like to...

encourage children to gather flowers from the garden and arrange them in a vase or jar in your home.



If your child is having a friend over for a play-date involve your child in the preparation of snacks for the occasion.

Encourage children to greet guests with a big smile – the best way to make someone feel welcome!

Perhaps they might like to make a welcome sign to go on the front door or in a front lobby.
