- crayons

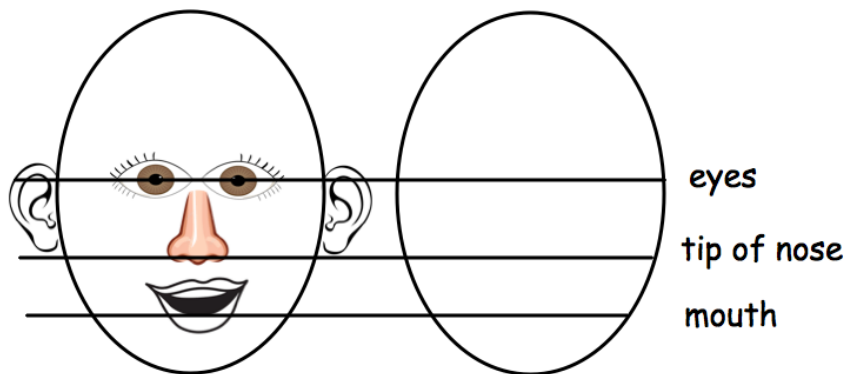
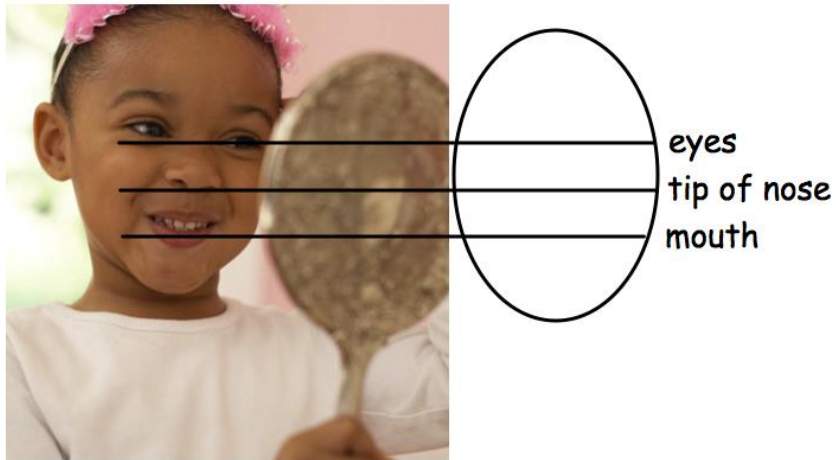
What to do:

- make your best smile
- look in the mirror.
- look at the shape of your lips
- look at the shape of your eyes
- draw yourself just as you see yourself.



Older children might like to think about the proportions of their face – see next page.

The proportions of a face



When you draw a face

- the eyes are about halfway on the face shape
- the tip of the nose is about half way between the eyes and the chin
- the mouth is about half way between the tip of the nose and the chin
- ears are about level with the eyes.
