

Every One Counted

You will need:

- paper plates
- crayons
- wool in a variety of colours
- scissors, PVA glue, glue spreaders
- Bible verse: God knows how many hairs are on your head.
Matthew 10:29-31

What to do:

- Draw a face on a paper plate.
- Cut wool into a variety of lengths and stick wool on to the top of the plate to make hair.
- It would be good to have lots of different bright colours for hair and not just brown, black or yellow wool. Children can have fun making the hair as outlandish as they like. They can also give the neck a necklace or a tie or a collar.
- Glue the Bible verse around the bottom of the plate.
- Talk about how we are all precious to God, so precious that God knows how many hairs we have on our heads.
