## Paper Plate Bird in Nest

## You will need:

- paper plate
- blue cellophane, blue paper or blue paint
- wool scraps, raffia bits, paper strips
- light blue or cream paper or card for eggs
- cut-out sparrows on cardboard
- coloured pencils or textas
- PVA glue, glue sticks, scissors

## What to do:

- Cut out a semi-circle of blue cellophane or paper to fit the top half of the paper plate. Glue it in place.
- \*Alternative: Paint the paper plate blue and allow to dry.
- Spread PVA glue over the bottom half of the paper plate, then stick on a variety of raffia bits, wool scraps and paper strips to make the nest.
- Draw 2-3 egg shapes on the light blue or cream paper or card. Sparrow eggs are only 2cm long. Make speckled marks on the eggs with a brown pencil.
- Cut the eggs out and glue them in the nest
- Print the sparrows below, colour one or both birds, referring to the coloured pictures of the sparrows, then cut them out and glue them onto cardboard, then onto the nest. *Or:* Use the coloured sparrow pictures themselves.

Alternative: Cut out bird shapes from coloured card and glue them in the nest. Make eyes and a beak and glue them on the bird's head.

Cut out the Bible verse below and glue it to the nest, or to the top
