

Lunch Bag Craft

Materials:

- brown paper plates or brown paper to cover white plates
- paper plate rim for handle (it can be white)
- fish and bread rolls photocopied or glued onto cardboard
- printed message
- *Optional:* alfoil
- scissors, glue sticks
- stapler, sticky tape

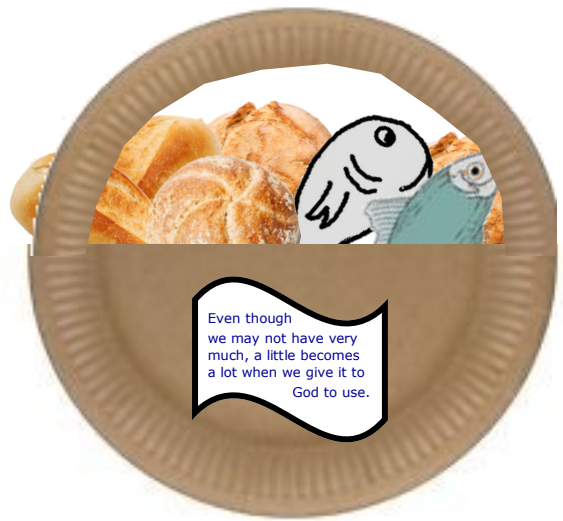
Each child will need:

- 1½ paper plates (can be small or large)
- 5 loaf shapes
- 2 fish shapes
- *Optional:* alfoil
- *Optional:* Use hologram or silver glitter on the fish instead of alfoil
- printed message

What to do:

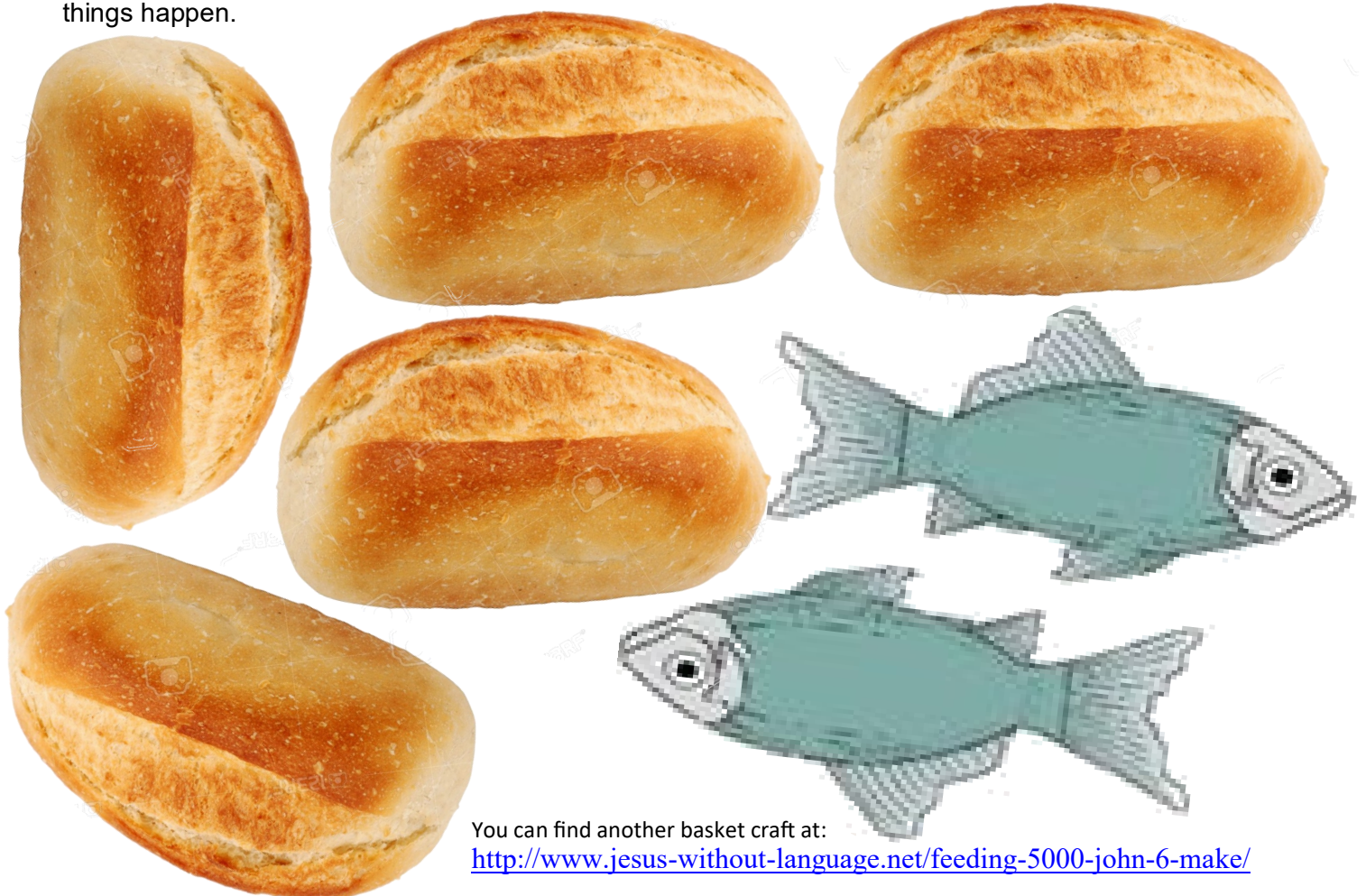
- Cut the paper plate in half.
- Staple, glue or sticky tape the two halves together around the outside curved edge. *Optional:* If using a white plate cut brown paper to cover the plate and glue or staple it on.
- Trim the rim from the half plate. Glue or sticky tape it to the basket at each end for a handle.
- Glue the printed message to the front of the basket.
- Cut out 5 loaves and two fish.
- *Optional:* Cover the fish in alfoil or add glitter.
- Add the fish and rolls to the basket.

Talk about how every little bit helps, from little things big things grow, and if we do what we can, even if we think it isn't very much, we never know how God will use what we do to make surprising and great things happen.
