a mirror sheets of white paper preferably cartridge crayons


What to do:


make your best smile look in the mirror. look at the shape of your lips look at the shape of you eyes draw yourself just as you see yourself.

The proportions of a face





When you draw a face

- the eyes are about halfway on the face shape
- the tip of the nose is about half way between the eyes and the chin
- the mouth is about half way between the tip of the nose and the chin
 - ears are about level with the eyes.
